## ENAGE

Raising Awareness: Unbelievers having their first exposure to Christianity and possibly their need of a Savior or the existence of Christ's Church.

Initial Contact: Unbeliever meets a Christian or group of Christians (attends a church service), perhaps even reads a Bible for the first time.

Building Relationships: This is pre-evangelism. Your friendships with unbelievers are adorning the gospel by your godly lifestyle and loving attitude.

## EVANGELIZE

Sharing Christ: The gospel is prayerfully explained to the unbelievers (usually through a Christian) and an appeal is made for repentance and faith.

## ESTABLISH

Follow-Up: Coming alongside a new Christian and explaining to them the basics of biblical doctrine and how to life out their new life in Christ.

Encourage: Helping faith grow in another believer through loving comfort and correction by the prayerful speaking of God's work and acts of mercy.

## EQUIP

Being Trained: Receiving instruction in theology and ministry skills from someone else for specific ministry service to the church or unbelievers.

Training: Giving instruction in theology and ministry skills from someone else for specific ministry service to the church or unbelievers.
